Dianne is co-owner of ADFA and has been involved with aviation for the past 20 years. Dianne is ADFA's Student Liaison Officer and Administration Officer.





## (COMMERCIAL PILOT'S LICENCE)

The course involves a 4 phase learning system on a number of different beginner and advanced aircraft. We will not only train you to become a commercial pilot but we will train you to be an Aviation Specialist.



### **Course Overview**

To gain a commercial pilots licence you will need at least 150 hours of flight experience, with specified time spent as Pilot in Command, and both cross country and instrument flight experience.

The training for the CPL is aimed at achieving a high standard of flying skill, knowledge and airmanship. You will be specifically instructed in the procedures for conducting commercial operations. This will include the management of passengers as well as the management of the aircraft. You will consolidate all your knowledge and practical skill in navigation exercises, carrying out normal procedures and all types of emergency procedures. You will practice making many command decisions under pressure and in various circumstances in order to simulate real life situations and increase situational awareness.

After passing the CPL flight test, you will be issued with the Commercial Pilot Licence. This licence entitles you to carry passengers for hire and reward. You can now act as Pilot In Command of a single pilot aircraft in a commercial role working for an operator.

The multi-engine rating is one of the more important of ratings, for a long time you have been flying aircraft with just one engine, now putting two engines into the mix makes it a challenging yet enjoyable learning curve. You will learn the emergency procedures and airmanship qualities required to fly these advanced machines.

You can now fly any piston, multi-engine aircraft for which you are endorsed and once you have 5 hours in command on type you can begin charter operations.

### **COURSE COST \$85,200.00**

Course includes the flying hours and sim hours listed which includes fuel, pre-flight briefings, post flight briefings, theory courses and text books.

Disclaimer: Costs do not include flight hours required for flight tests, the CASA flight examiners fees, maps, charts and any CASA documents, CASA theory exams, aviation medical, any extra landing fees, headsets and any re-training that may be required and any multi engine training.

The number of hours indicated are based on the number of hours that through our experience we believe are achievable targets, they are not based on the CASA Minimum requirements.

Every effort is made to ensure the students finish on time and on budget, however if the course hours are exceeded, the extra hours will be charged at the aircraft hourly rate current at that time.

### **ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS**

The minimum entry level to train at Aero Dynamic Flight Academy is an IELTS level 5.5 or higher – all students must have achieved this score prior to commencing their training at the academy. Students who don't have a score of 5.5 will need to enrol in an English course then sit the IELTS or equivalent English test.

In addition, the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) requires proof of an Aviation Language International Test of English (ALITE) of at least level 4 (operational english) or above, before international students are able to fly solo during their flight training or before they can complete their Private Pilot Licence exams (PPL).
