

Michael has been involved in education and training for the past 15 years. He was awarded the NQ Community Leader of the Year award by the Institute of Managers and Leaders in 2017.

Amongst other things, Michael once worked as a tour guide on the Kokoda Track in Papua New Guinea. He has also been the Head of Department for Sport and Vocational Education and Training (VET) at secondary schools in North Queensland.
